The conference programme will start on Wednesday 8th June with masterclasses & tours of EY's brand new LEED Platinum headquarters in Stockholm.



Sustainable work-life is about enabling working and living conditions to support people in engaging and performing in work throughout an extended working life. Making work sustainable requires technical and workplace design as a prerequisite to create high-quality jobs. Recent global EY study shows a shift of power towards the employee, who favors hybrid working models, whereas they don't feel they get it. In addition, compensation and career opportunities are in the top of employee focus. From a Behavior point of view, sustainable work-life can look at organizational structures (flexibility in work arrangements, pay structures, managerial support, etc.) and individual empowerment (lifelong learning, upskilling, development, etc.) to meet these needs. The Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD) from EU will further emphasize the need for companies to work in this direction.
